Producer's Notes:

Over the course of 2020 the world and its citizens continued to deal with one historical situation after another. It seemed as if we would never stop living in unprecedented times.

This year Collin Theatre Center has successfully produced three shows (now four). Our students and faculty have created performance art when the industry has been shuttered. We have done it with all COVID safety protocols being followed. In my opinion, it has been one of our biggest challenges in our 35-year history. Our brains have only begun to process the traumatic events that have happened over the last 18 months.

After such a tough year, we need to begin healing as human beings. Two steps in the healing process are recovery and rebuilding. This year's festival asked playwrights where we were in that process. To use the theme of recovery and rebuilding to show how we as humans can move forward after experiencing any kind of trauma. For some the answer was to learn to live with our mistakes, others thought Zoom! We had awesome submissions from community members, students, alumni, and current faculty. We filmed them in the Black Box Theatre on the Plano Campus and have stitched them together to tell a much larger story: the story of us.
