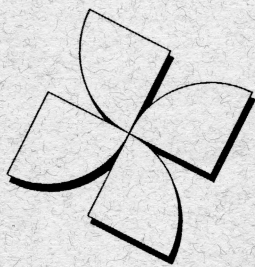

Shakespeare in the Summer

When you think of summer in the Metroplex, do you also think of Shakespeare? Many of us flock each summer to the annual Shakespeare Festival in Dallas. Now you can enjoy summer Shakespeare at Spring Creek Campus.

"Romeo and Juliet" marks the first production in an ambitious project for the Quad C Theatre program.

Patterned after the Joseph Papp Shakespeare Festival in New York City, the Spring Creek Summer Shakespeare Festival will become an annual summer event in Plano. The festival will present semi-professional, full-scale productions of each of Shakespeare's works over the next few years.

Jamie Lawrence is directing "Romeo and Juliet." He is a professor of drama at the University of Texas at Dallas and a member of the acting company for the Shakespeare Festival of Dallas. Janet Hurley, associate fight director for the Shakespeare Festival of Dallas, is staging the production's fights. The designers are Brendan Quigley (sets), Dan Vilter (lights) and Sandy Snyder (costumes and makeup).

The cast is a collection of professional and amateur performers from across the Metroplex. Brian Hoffman and Kelley Graham play the title roles, the LRC's very own Carol Worsnop plays Juliet's nurse, and CCCC theatre veteran and LRC staffer Steve Searl plays Lord Capulet.
