## COLLIN COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE STYLE GUIDELINES

### Office of Public Information

1. The use of "Collin County Community College District" is preferred on first mention over "Collin County Community College." When speaking about events or groups, use "Collin County Community College", unless reference is made to the district as it involves all campuses or as a governmental entity.

EXAMPLE 1: The Collin County Community College Madrigal Singers will perform at 6 pm tonight. Mike Crawford, CCCC CD choral director, will also present a special solo.

EXAMPLE 2: He is running for a place on the Board of Trustees of the Collin County Community College District.

2. The abbreviation for the College is CCCC CD. Never use C.C.C.C. or C.C.C.C.D.

3.\* Refer to the College as "Collin County Community College District" or "Collin County Community College" on first reference and as CCCC CD on all subsequent references. When referring to CCCC CD as "the College" or "the District," DO capitalize "College" or "District."

EXAMPLE: The computer is the property of Collin County Community College District. It is, however, not housed at the College.
