but me

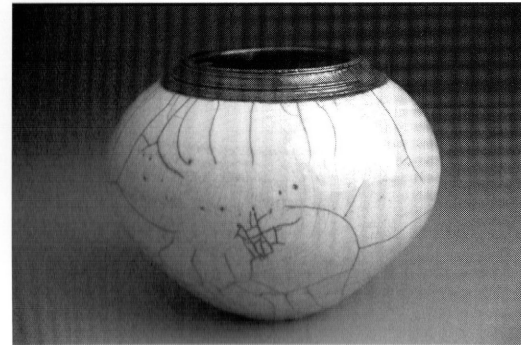
